WEEK OF March 6, 2017

PLAN COMMISSION

On Tuesday, March 7, the Plan Commission held a public hearing on a request by Spark Hire to install a wall sign over 20-feet at 1500 Skokie Boulevard. There were no public comments and the Plan Commission unanimously recommended approval, with the condition that the two existing wall signs be removed prior to installation of the new sign.

The next Plan Commission meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 18.

UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON AIR QUALITY MONITORING STATION

The University of Washington at Seattle has requested permission from the Village to place air quality monitoring equipment on the roof of the Village's Water Plant. As part of their studies of air pollution and air quality, the equipment will be in for approximately two years. The Village has had similar agreements with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for their use of the Water Plant roof for almost 20 years.

LONE TREE WATER MAIN PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor began installing 8-inch water main along Tamarind Drive and Huehl Road. The installation on Tamarind and Huehl Road is anticipated to be completed next week. Once installation is complete, pressure testing and chlorination of the new water mains will begin.



DUNDEE ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

This week, IDOT began mobilizing equipment in order to complete the intersection improvements on Dundee Road at Landwehr and Pfingsten Roads. The curb lane going northbound on Pfingsten will be closed in order to complete storm sewer work. Work on both traffic signals is anticipated to begin on Monday, March 13. Traffic signal work is anticipated to be completed by early May.

METRA STATION IMPROVEMENTS

The Northbrook Metra station improvements will begin Saturday, April 1, and are scheduled to be completed by the end of May. The improvements include new doors, windows, roof replacement, exterior concrete stairs, vestibules, addition of an ADA ramp, exterior railing replacements and interior tile floor repairs. Roof replacement work is tentatively scheduled to start Saturday, April 1, weather permitting. This construction may result in longer lines at the parking machines, so commuters should allow extra time while improvements are underway.
