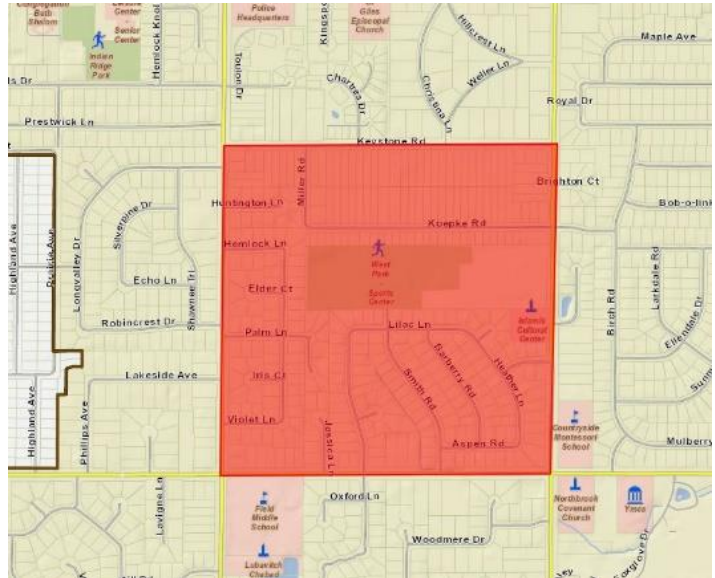

PARKWAY TREE TRIMMING PROGRAM

Each year, the Village of Northbrook trims parkway trees using contractual assistance. Trees are trimmed to prevent unnecessary damage during storms, protect pedestrians and motorists from low hanging branches, promote the health of the tree, and ensure the tree is aesthetically pleasing. Trees are trimmed during their dormant period in the winter months to minimize trauma to the tree. Trimming is currently occurring in the area bounded by Pfingsten Road to the east, Landwehr Road to the west, Keystone Road to the north, and Techy Road to the south (pictured right).
