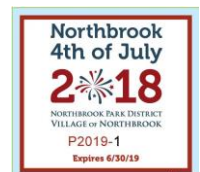
VILLAGE VEHICLE STICKERS & PET LICENSES NOW AVAILABLE

All motor vehicles registered to a Northbrook address (residential or business) are required to have Village vehicle stickers. Only persons residing within the corporate limits of the Village are allowed to purchase a Northbrook vehicle sticker. Stickers must be displayed by midnight, Saturday, June 30. Please note: The Village Hall lobby is open Monday – Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Extended hours in June are from 9am to noon on Saturdays, and until 6:30 p.m. on Tuesdays. Purchase your vehicle sticker before noon on Saturday, June 30, for the lower rate. Automobile stickers are \$30. After noon on Saturday, June 30, stickers are \$38.

Persons living in unincorporated Northbrook must only purchase a Cook County vehicle sticker. These are available at the Northfield Township office, 847-724-8300.

Support 4th of July and Receive a Special Vehicle Sticker

Residents will again have an option to make a donation, minimum \$20 per sticker, to help support Northbrook's 4th of July festivities. There are only 2,000 special vehicle stickers, so purchase yours early. This year's 4th of July sticker features the 2018 4th of July logo.



The 2018/19 standard vehicle sticker features the Northbrook Days Festival logo celebrating Northbrook Civic Foundation's annual fundraiser and their service to the community since 1925.



MEMORIAL DAY PARADE AND CEREMONY

On Monday, May 28, hundreds of residents and visitors attended Northbrook's Memorial Day parade and ceremony. Northbrook Bicycle Patrol Unit Officers Mike Tadley, James Friel, Keith Schultz, Marc Fainman, and Brendan Cain (pictured right) assisted other officers with crowd control, security, and street closings during the parade. The ceremony included welcoming remarks by Village President Sandy Frum, keynote speaker Retired U.S. Army Lt. Col. James Ossey, and a special presentation of the Table of the Fallen Soldier. Northbrook residents can watch the parade and ceremony, which airs daily at 9am and 5pm in June, on NCTV- Cable Channel 17 (ATT U-Verse subscribers, tune to channel 99 and search Northbrook).



WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT & RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor completed installation of water main on Western Avenue between Oak Avenue and Maple Avenue, and storm sewer work at the intersection of Western and Oak. Crews also continued pressure testing and water sampling the new main between Techny and Illinois Roads.

Next week, the Village's contractor will begin installing water service lines on Western for homes between Techny and Asbury Roads. Staff anticipates the contractor will also begin making water main interconnections between the new main along Western and the existing main at each side street. Each interconnection will require water outages while the work is completed. Prior to outages, staff will provide notice to impacted residents.

CHARLEMAGNE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor completed the installation of the new 8-inch water main on Bordeaux Drive and started work on the north end of the project at Dauphine Avenue. Next week, crews will pressure test and chlorinate the new main and begin installing new water service lines on Bordeaux Drive.

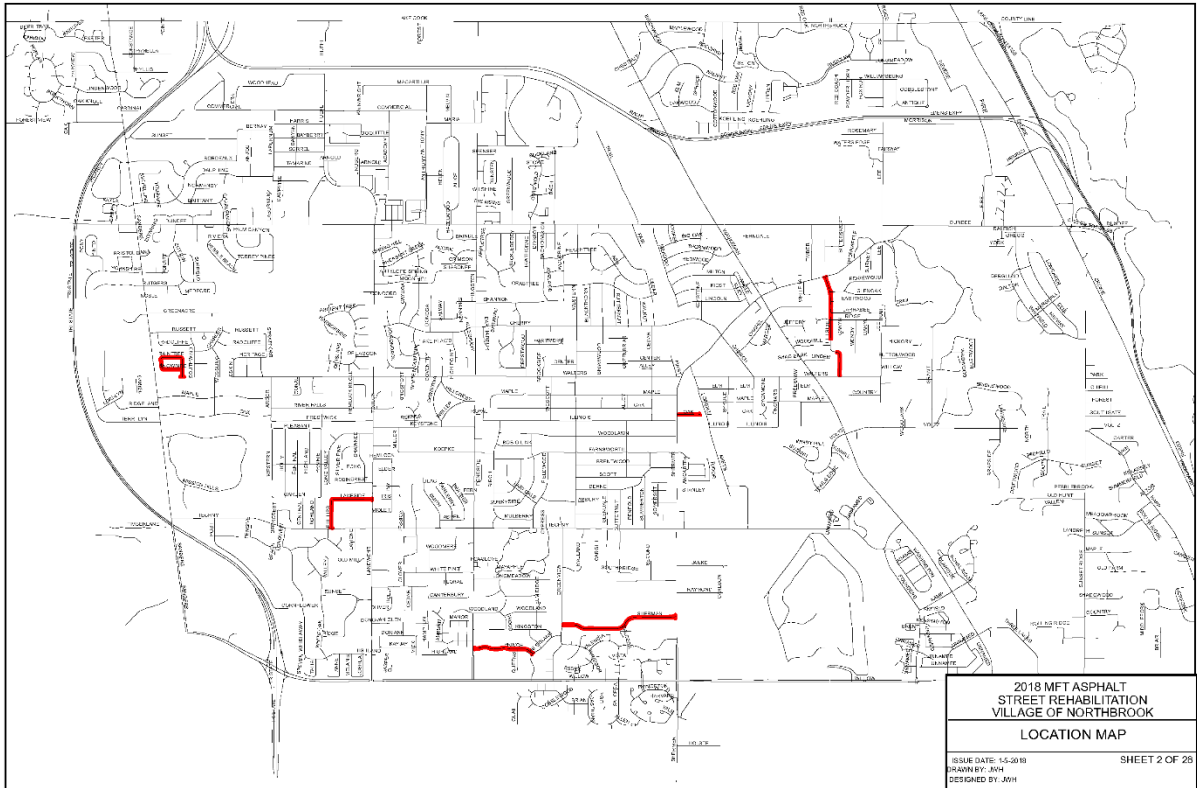

2018 ASPHALT STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM

This week, the Village's contractor removed and poured new concrete curbs and sidewalk on the streets included in this year's asphalt street resurfacing program (see the map below). Crews also began repairing and adjusting utility structures in anticipation of street grinding.

Next week, the contractor plans to begin grinding operations on all streets included in this year's program, with the exception of Sherman Drive, which will occur later in the summer. Crews will also complete patching work to repair asphalt driveways impacted by the curb replacement.
