WEEK OF June 11, 2018

SPECIAL VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

On Tuesday, June 12, the Board of Trustees held a special meeting. Under President's Report, President Frum made several Commission appointments and recognized the 10th season of the Northbrook Farmers Market.

Under the Consent Agenda, the Board approved a number of resolutions and ordinances including the purchase of computers, Fire Department turnout gear, a replacement dump truck and fork lift; contracts for software maintenance, pavement marking services, fire hydrant sandblasting and painting services, hauling and processing of electronic waste; and ascertaining the prevailing rate of wages in Cook County.

Under Planning and Zoning, the Board heard a preliminary review of a request to rezone 237 Melvin Drive to Intuitional Building District for Northfield Township Road District Headquarters/Yard, and a request from Engaged Senior Homes, LLC for a Zoning Code text amendment to create a use category for Senior Living Group Homes in Single Family Residential. Both were referred to the Plan Commission for review.

Under Public Safety, the Board heard comments from citizens during a discussion of the enforcement of the Cook County Assault Weapons Ban. President Frum read a statement clarifying that we have been advised by the Cook County Sheriff's office that its police department will take primary responsibility for enforcement of the ordinance within Northbrook, and the Cook County State's Attorney will be responsible for prosecution of violations.

The next Regular Village Board meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 26, at 7:30 p.m.

POLICE DEPARTMENT NEWS

On Saturday evening, June 9, Northbrook's NIPAS Emergency Services Team representatives responded to the McHenry Police Department to assist with a barricaded subject known to have several firearms in his residence. A search warrant was obtained for the residence and the subject was taken into custody without incident. The scene was turned over to the McHenry Police Department.

On Wednesday, June 13, a swearing in ceremony was held for Police Department promotions of Deputy Chief Dan Strickland, Commander Mark Graf, and Sergeant Marc Fainman. A formal ceremony will be held at the Village Board meeting on June 26. On Friday, a celebration was held for retiring Deputy Chief Mike O'Malley.. Congratulations to those promoted and we wish Mike the best in his retirement.



WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT & RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor connected Wescott School's water service line to the new main on Western Avenue and completed interconnections between the new main and the existing main at Dehne and Asbury Roads.

Next week, crews will continue interconnection work moving north along Western at the intersections with Scott Road and Brentwood Road. This work will require water outages while the connections to the mains are made. Residents impacted by the water outage will be notified in advance of the work occurring.


CHARLEMAGNE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor started installing service lines to individual residences on Bordeaux Drive. 2018 ASPHALT STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM

This week, the Village's contractor completed installation of the final surface course of asphalt on most of the streets included in this year's program (see the map below). On Tuesday, June 19, the final surface course will be installed on Hillcrest Drive, Prince Street, and Oak Avenue, weather permitting. Work on Sherman Drive will follow later this summer.

EDENS SPUR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Illinois Tollway has started a multi-year repair and reconstruction project on the Edens Spur (I-94). This project includes roadway repair and reconstruction work between Lake-Cook Road and the Edens Expressway, as well as the replacement of the Pfingsten Road bridge over the Edens, repairs to the Waukegan Road bridge over the Edens, and median and lighting improvements. During this work, the Tollway will be closing lanes and shifting traffic as necessary.

The first segment of the project began this week with concrete work on the Edens Spur between Lake-Cook Road and Pfingsten Road. The Tollway anticipates replacing the Pfingsten Road bridge in 2019. This project will require closure of the bridge for an anticipated four months. Additionally, the ramps from Waukegan Road to the Spur will be closed for two months during their reconstruction. Detours will be posted for both routes.
