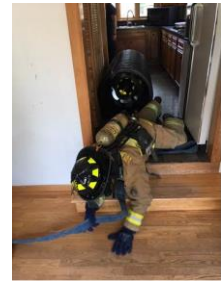
WEEK OF July 16, 2018

ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COMMISSION MEETING

On Thursday, July 19, the Environmental Quality Commission held its regular meeting during which Commissioners discussed the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus' Greenest Region Compact 2 (GRC2) initiative and the Village's Sustainability Plan. The Commission will continue reviewing the GRC2 initiative and Sustainability Plan at the August 16 meeting.

FIRE DEPARTMENT TRAINING

Members of the Northbrook Fire Department participated in advanced SCBA (self-contained breathing apparatus) drills this week using a home scheduled for demolition. With the resident's permission, members of NBFD performed and practiced advanced skills (wall breach, mayday drill, emergency procedures, etc.) in hands-on realistic scenarios.



FIRE DEPARTMENT MUTUAL AID

On Wednesday, July 18, the Northbrook Fire Department provided mutual aid to Prospect Heights for an apartment building fire. Three apartment buildings containing at least 72 units were severely damaged. Northbrook's ambulance transported a patient and Chief Carlson assisted with incident command.



WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT & RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor removed pavement from the northbound lanes of Western Avenue from Techny Road to Farnsworth Lane and laid the new base. Crews also placed the first asphalt layers between Techny Road and Farnsworth Lane.

Next week, crews will pave the northbound lanes between Farnsworth Lane and Oak Avenue. Crews will then remove pavement in the southbound lanes starting at Techny and moving north.

CHARLEMAGNE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

This week, the Village’s contractor removed and replaced damaged concrete driveways, sidewalks, and street panels that resulted from recent water main work. Crews also began restoration on Bordeaux Road. Next week, reconstruction will occur on Dauphine and restoration work will continue on Bordeaux Road and Normandy Lane.

FARNSWORTH LANE CONCRETE PATCHING

This week, the Village’s contractor removed and patched the final portions of concrete on Farnsworth Lane between Western Avenue and Ellendale Drive. This work is part of the Wescott Park Stormwater Project’s warranty agreement. Next week, the contractor will seal remaining joints between the concrete panels.

2018 ASPHALT STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM

Next week, the Village’s contractor will resume the 2018 Asphalt Street Resurfacing Program. The program’s final portion will focus on milling and resurfacing Sherman Drive between Shermer and Greenview Roads. The Village will coordinate with Glenbrook North High School and Maple School during this portion of the project.
