PLAN COMMISSION MEETING

On Tuesday, October 30, the Plan Commission held a special meeting to adopt a resolution recommending denial of an application requesting relief for North Shore Sports & Wellness located at 555 Huehl Road. The Plan Commission's recommendation of denial will be presented to the Board on November 13.

AD HOC FACILITIES MEETING

On Tuesday, October 30, the Ad Hoc Facilities Committee of the Village Board held a meeting to review the space needs analysis for the Police Department, Fire Station 11 and Fleet Maintenance Garage. The Committee posed additional questions for staff review and follow-up at a meeting to be scheduled for early 2019.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS COMMISSION MEETING

On Thursday, November 1, the Community Relations Commission held its regular meeting. At the meeting, the Commission reviewed the work of each of its subcommittees and began discussing its 2019 event calendar. The next regular Commission meeting will be held on Thursday, January 3, 2019.

WESTERN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT & RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

At this time, the project is substantially complete. Next week, crews will finish any minor punch list items that are remaining. The Village thanks area residents, District 30 and Northbrook Park District for their cooperation during this project.

DEHNE ROAD/GLENDALE AVENUE, WOODLAWN ROAD AND ELM RIDGE DRIVE STORMWATER PROJECTS

This week, crews installed the new culvert on Elm Ridge Drive (pictured right). Next week, crews will begin final grading and restorations for the Dehne Road/Glendale Avenue, Woodlawn Road and Elm Ridge projects.

1000 SKOKIE BOULEVARD ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

This week, the developer's contractor poured new concrete curb and continued construction of the new right-turn lane from Sunset Ridge Road to



southbound Skokie Boulevard. Next week, crews will begin placing the first layers of asphalt on the western side of Skokie. During this work, access will be maintained to all businesses located in the area. As a reminder, this work is being completed as part of the 1000 Skokie Boulevard development and will include pavement widening on Skokie and installation of a dedicated right-turn lane from Sunset Ridge Road to southbound Skokie.

SHERMER ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

This week, the Village’s contractor installed the posts for the new bridge fencing and began preparations to pave the asphalt street segments located on either side of the bridge. Next week, crews will pave those areas, groove the bridge deck and remove any unneeded equipment from the work area.

CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT INFRASTRUCTURE AND STREETScape PROJECT

This week, the Village’s contractor began work on the pedestrian improvements on Shermer Road. Installation of the bump out and pedestrian island are expected to resume next week, after resolution of a utility conflict. This work will require lane closures, however two-way traffic will be maintained. Once this work is complete, the final layer of asphalt will be put down.

FALL 2018 TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

Beginning on Monday, November 12, the Village’s contractor will begin the Fall 2018 parkway tree planting program. This program will include planting 110 trees in the community. Any impacted properties have been notified of the upcoming work.

COMED TREE TRIMMING PROGRAM

As part of its regular maintenance program, ComEd regularly trims trees and branches that interfere with power lines. ComEd crews are currently trimming in two separate areas of the Village. The first area is bounded by Lake-Cook Road to the north, Pfingsten Road to the east, Dundee Road to the south and Sanders Road to the west. The second area is bounded by Techny Road to the north, Greenview Road to the east, Willow Road to the south, and I-294 to the west.
