## WEEK OF November 5, 2018

### VETERANS DAY SERVICE ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 11 AND WEEKEND DISPLAY

Veterans Day is a time to thank and honor all those who served in the military, both in wartime and peacetime. Remember our Veterans, as well as those currently serving, at this year's 100-Year Anniversary of the Armistice Veterans Day Service on Sunday, November 11, 10:30 a.m. at Northbrook Jr. High Gymnasium, 1475 Maple Avenue. The American Legion Post #791 and the Veterans of Foreign Wars invite all to assemble for a service to honor those who served the armed forces: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, and Coast Guard.

### DEHNE ROAD/GLENDALE AVENUE, WOODLAWN ROAD, AND ELM RIDGE DRIVE STORMWATER PROJECTS

This week, the Village's contractor continued restoration work at each project's work site. Crews poured new concrete for sidewalks along Woodlawn Road and for curb and gutter on Elm Ridge Drive. The contractor also continued ditch-grading work on Glendale Avenue and Woodlawn.

### 1000 SKOKIE BOULEVARD ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

This week, the developer's contractor poured new curb and gutter on the west side of Skokie Boulevard and began preparatory work for additional paving on Skokie Boulevard. Next week, crews will pave hot-mix asphalt on the west side of the roadway. During this work, access to all businesses in the area will remain open. As a reminder, this work is being completed as part of the 1000 Skokie Boulevard development and will include pavement widening on Skokie Boulevard and installation of a dedicated right-turn lane from Sunset Ridge Road to southbound Skokie Boulevard.

### SHERMER ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

This week, the Village's contractor grooved the bridge deck and began layout of the brick parapet walls. Next week, crews will continue installing brick and stone on the parapets.

CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT INFRASTRUCTURE AND STREETScape PROJECT

Next week, the Village’s contractor will resume work on the pedestrian improvements on Shermer Road following the resolution of a utility conflict. This work is expected to be complete by the end of the week, weather permitting. Work will require lane closures, but two-way traffic will be maintained. Once this work is complete, Shermer Road will be ground and the final asphalt surface will be put down.

FALL 2018 TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

On Monday, November 12, the Village’s contractor will begin the Fall 2018 parkway tree planting program. This program will include the planting of 110 trees in the community. At this time, any impacted properties have been notified of the work.


COMED TREE TRIMMING PROGRAM

As part of its regular maintenance program, ComEd regularly trims trees and branches that interfere with power lines. ComEd crews are currently trimming in two areas of the Village. The first area is bounded by Lake-Cook Road to the north, Pfingsten Road to the east, Dundee Road to the south and Sanders Road to the west. The second area is bounded by Techny Road to the north, Greenview Road to the east, Willow Road to the south, and I-294 to the west.
