POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY

On Monday, March 25, Northbrook's MCAT representatives responded to a vehicle accident with personal injury on Brentwood Road. The female subject was pronounced dead at the hospital.

DUNDEE ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

This week, the Illinois Department of Transportation's (IDOT) contractor continued construction of the compensatory stormwater storage for the Dundee Road Culvert Project. Dundee Road, between Waukegan Road and Skokie Boulevard, will be closed to through traffic from approximately Monday, April 15 – October 31. Traffic will be detoured to Lake-Cook Road via Waukegan Road and Skokie Boulevard during this time (see the detour map to the right). IDOT's road closure signage will be



posted on Monday, April 1, to inform motorists. Additionally, the Village will place signs in and around the project area to help direct motorists to area businesses.

This project includes the replacement of the existing culvert and road above the culvert located at the intersection of Dundee and Lee Roads. This work will require the Village's 24-inch cast iron water distribution main on the north side of Dundee Road, the 12-inch water main on the west side of Lee Road, and a section of the 15-inch sanitary sewer also located on the north side of Dundee Road be relocated to avoid any conflicts during the project. ANTHONY TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT-SKY HARBOR BUSINESS PARK

This week, the Village's contractor completed saw cutting the concrete roadway and removing and replacing the existing underground storm sewer (pictured right). Next week, crews will begin removing the roadway. During this initial stage, traffic will be detoured to Macarthur Avenue via Wainwright Drive and Commercial Avenue. SHERMER ROAD BRIDGE PROJECT

Beginning next week, the Village's contractor will resume work on the Shermer Road Bridge. The remaining work includes installing the brick sidewalk and parapet walls and is expected to be complete by April 30. This work will require daily lane closures but

Shermer Road will remain open to traffic throughout the project. The Village placed changeable message boards on Shermer Road to inform motorists of the bridge work and remind them that Shermer Road remains open. CONCRETE ISLAND REPAIRS

Beginning Monday, April 1, Public Works crews will repair the concrete island at Shermer Road and Church Street following a vehicle accident that knocked down the traffic signal and damaged the concrete sidewalk and ADA panels. This work will require intermittent lane closures as crews work in the area but all traffic lanes will remain open for the duration of this project. Staff anticipates the repair work will be complete by the week of April 8.

CONCRETE PATCH REPAIRS ON COMMERCIAL AVENUE

On Monday, April 1, the Village's contractor will begin concrete pavement patching in the 4000 block of Commercial Avenue (see map to the right). This work is limited to the south side of the roadway and requires a temporary lane shift to complete the work and allow the new concrete to cure. Staff anticipates all work will be complete on Friday, April 5.



1000 SKOKIE BOULEVARD ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

This week, work on the 1000 Skokie Boulevard roadway project resumed with the installation of new landscaping and final restoration. These improvements will require daily lane closures but the road will remain open to traffic throughout the project. Staff anticipates this work will be complete by Friday, June 28. This work is part of the 1000 Skokie Boulevard development and includes pavement widening on Skokie and installation of a dedicated right-turn lane from Sunset Ridge Road to Skokie.

PLEIN AIR PAINTINGS AT SUNSET
