Spencer will begin each day with a brief introduction and discussion of the day's events. He will discuss composition and design. How to simplify your composition by editing out unwanted clutter, focusing on large shapes and abbreviated values. He will discuss various aspects of watercolor, i.e. differences in brushes, papers, paint quality, as well as brush manipulation, washes, splattering, dropping and dry brushing. When, where and how to appropriately use each tool and technique. This workshop will be dynamic in that it will be customized to the participating artists. At least the initial paintings will be step-by-step progressions demonstrated by Spencer and then replicated by students. Create art work either from your own reference photos or from those supplied by the Spencer. There will be an hour lunch each day.
