**ELECTRIC AGGREGATION PROGRAM NOTICE**

Dear Resident or Small Business Owner,

The North Shore Electricity Aggregation Consortium is a group of seven communities formed by the Villages of Deerfield, Glencoe, Lake Bluff, Northbrook, and Skokie along with the Cities of Highland Park and Lake Forest focused on securing affordable electric aggregation supply for its residents and small businesses. The Consortium selected Chicago-based MC Squared Energy Services, LLC to serve the Consortium with electric supply through October 2024. Each participating community within the Consortium will be provided a civic contribution annually from MC Squared that will be used to meet sustainability goals and objectives established by each community. MC Squared will provide eligible residents and small businesses with electricity supply **pricing equal to the monthly ComEd published tariff supply rate** during the 28-month term of the electric aggregation program.



**PRIMARY BENEFIT OF PROGRAM**

By participating in the Consortium's municipal electric aggregation program, you will help Northbrook support our Climate Action Plan goals such as increased renewable energy use and support for local sustainability programs, at **NO** increased cost above the published ComEd tariff rates.

**YOU WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ENROLLED IN THIS PROGRAM UNLESS YOU OPT-OUT BY  
MAY-6-2022**

- You are **still** a ComEd customer for electricity delivery and metering purposes at your home or business.
- You will continue to pay ComEd in the same manner as you currently do. There is no change in billing under the Consortium's electric aggregation program.
- Under this program, your electricity supply cost will be the same as the monthly ComEd published tariff rates. Electric supply from MC Squared does not cost more than the ComEd published tariff supply rate.
- ComEd continues to be responsible for the wires, poles, and all emergencies, including outage restoration.
- There are no enrollment, switching or early termination fees under the Consortium's electric aggregation program.

**You are not required to do anything to participate** in the Electric Aggregation Program. MC Squared will automatically process your enrollment. You will pay the same rate as the published monthly ComEd tariff supply rate.

There are no enrollment fees or early termination fees.**

If you do not opt out of the Electric Aggregation Program, you will be deemed to have authorized and agreed to your enrollment and to have your electric service with MC Squared under the enclosed Terms and Conditions and the Uniform Disclosure Statement.
