Early Voting:

Early voting for the 2025 Consolidated General Election continues through Monday, March 31 at Northbrook Village Hall and other locations. DEA – National RX Take Back Day:

The Northbrook Police Department will be participating in the DEA National Prescription Take Back Day. Residents can dispose of unused medication that is placed in a Ziploc bag by bringing it to the Northbrook Police Department at 1401 Landwehr Road, Northbrook, IL 60062 on April 26, 2025, from 10am to 2pm. *Needles and inhalers will not be accepted.*

We will collect vape pens or other e-cigarette devices from individual consumers only after the batteries are removed from the devices. It is important to stress that we are not responsible for removing the batteries from the devices.

Nicor Gas Main Replacement Installation in Downtown Northbrook:

This week, Nicor wrapped up brick replacement at the Meadow and Shermer intersection and addressed the remaining brickwork on sidewalks and ramps. Additionally, Nicor reopened the entrance to the Metra Lot on Monday, March 24.

Looking ahead, Nicor will be working toward completing the rehabilitation of asphalt in the roadway and parking lane on Shermer Road between Meadow Road and the West Fork of the North Branch of the Chicago River. Soon, Nicor will also start repairs of the concrete roadway within the Metra right-of-way on Shermer Road. The Village appreciates everyone's patience as this work continues.

Northbrook Downtown Streetscape and Infrastructure Improvements:

This past week the project continued on the walkway along the west side of Meadow Road, north of Shermer Road. Additionally, the work began on the walkway along the north side of Shermer Road.

Next week, work will be on the walkway along both sides of Meadow Road, north of Shermer Road, as well as work on the walkway along the west side of Meadow Road, south of Shermer Road. This work will include concrete sidewalk removal and replacement, installation of ADA-compliant parking, as well as utility upgrades.



In preparation for the construction, a virtual open house was held March 5 with the adjacent businesses, and they were provided information and access to download a copy of the projected project schedule, presentation, and parking map to display at their business in order to keep customers informed during construction. Automated Water Meter Project:

Residents and businesses are receiving the project welcome letter. The letter, which comes from the Village and Veregy, introduces the project and provides information on what customers can expect in the next steps. Following the welcome letter, Veregy will mail postcards to customers allowing them to schedule their meter replacement.

Veregy mailed the first round of postcards to customers in billing section 1 on March 26. Meter replacements can only be scheduled after a postcard is received. Meter replacement appointments are scheduled in 2-hour windows but take approximately 30 minutes to complete. On March 18, 2025, Plan Commission training was held. Presented by the Village Attorney at a public meeting, members learned about the legal responsibilities of the role of a Plan Commission member. They reviewed the major considerations of special permits, variances, exceptions, rezoning, plan amendments, subdivisions, plat amendments, and text amendments. questions.
