## Meetings of the Village Board

## Activity Reports

- **Police Bulletin:** The weekly police bulletin has been updated for the week ending on [June 13, 2025](#).
- **Sales Tax Monthly Report:** The sales tax data for collections through June (March liability) continues to trend higher with \$602,000 more in monthly sales tax collected in June 2025 compared to June 2024. The increase is a result of both new businesses and a change in the law on how sales tax is determined and distributed to municipalities by the Illinois Department of Revenue. This sales tax report ([linked here](#)) includes a footnote disclosure regarding sales tax incentive payments. CFO Drazner additionally notes that starting with FY25, sales tax incentive payments are being charged to an expenditure account rather than netted against revenue.

### Updates

#### **Village Offices Closed on Juneteenth Holiday**

Juneteenth is a Federal Holiday on June 19. Village Hall and Public Works offices will be closed to the public. This holiday commemorates June 19, 1865, when Union troops marched to Galveston, Texas, freeing the last enslaved Black Americans more than two years after President Lincoln declared all enslaved persons free.

#### **Walking/Biking Path Repairs on Founders Drive – Week of June 16**

Public Works crews will begin asphalt repairs along the walking/biking path on Founders Drive, between Kamp Drive and Techny Road, weather permitting. Crews will grind down uneven areas and repave them with new hot mix asphalt. This project is expected to take approximately one week.


### Northbrook Downtown Infrastructure Improvements and Streetscape Enhancements

Removal and replacement of the failing infrastructure in the crosswalks at the intersection of Shermer and Meadow as well as Walters and Meadow is nearing completion. The contractor also continued installing landscaping and replacing temporary light poles throughout the site. Next week, work continues at intersections and installation of landscaping throughout the site.



## Automated Water Meter Project

The Village of Northbrook has reached 30% of new meters being installed since work began on Postcards have been mailed to customers in portions of all Billing Zones. These postcards outline the necessary steps to schedule an appointment for their meter to be replaced. Meter replacements can be scheduled after a customer receives a postcard. Meter replacement appointments are scheduled in 2-hour windows but take approximately 30 minutes to complete. Information on the Automated Water Meter Project is available [here](#).



## Shermer Road Corridor Improvements

Work is progressing on Shermer Road between Willow Road and Walters Avenue. This coming week, the contractor anticipates reopening the inner lanes on Shermer Road to allow for the shutdown of the outer lanes and the center turn lane will be utilized as part of the shirt for some northbound traffic. ## Cook County Roadway Construction Projects

Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways continues resurfacing work for the three projects within the Village:


- **Landwehr Road (Hampton Court in Glenview to Dundee Road)**
  - Completed work for this location includes installation of inlet filters, sidewalk saw cuts, silt fence installation, pavement binder, and pavement milling.
  - Next week, the sidewalk, resurfacing, and electrical work continues.
- **Sunset Ridge Road (Lake Avenue in Glenview to Skokie Boulevard)**
  - Completed work for this location includes installation of inlet filters, sidewalk saw

cuts, silt fence installation, storm sewer work, pavement binder, and pavement milling.

- Next week, resurfacing work and electrical work continues
- **Walters Road (Landwehr Road to Pfingsten Road)**
  - Completed work for this location includes installation of inlet filters, sidewalk construction, silt fence installation, storm sewer work, pavement binder, pavement surface, and pavement milling.
  - Next week, the County anticipates continuing electrical work.

## Spring Concrete and Asphalt Restoration

Public Works crews worked to complete restorations in various locations as shown on the map below. If the weather continues to cooperate, crews are on schedule to finish all restorations during the week of June 16.



## Tree Stump Removal Restoration

On Monday, June 9, Public Works crews completed restoration work of the 101 sites where tree stumps were previously removed.
