Due to scheduling adjustments, Public Works crews will begin asphalt repairs along the walking/biking path on Founders Drive, between Kamp Drive and Techny Road, weather permitting this coming week.

### **Northbrook Downtown Infrastructure Improvements and Streetscape Enhancements**

The contractor is continuing brick work in the intersection of Shermer and Walters along with landscaping improvements throughout the project. The contractor is scheduled to install the crosswalk markings prior to July 4th.



### **Cook County Roadway Construction Projects**

Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways continues resurfacing work for the three projects within the Village.

- ***Landwehr Road (Hampton Court in Glenview to Dundee Road)***
  - Completed work for this location includes installation of inlet filters, sidewalk saw cuts, silt fence installation, pavement binder, and pavement milling.
  - Sidewalk, resurfacing, and electrical work continues.
- ***Sunset Ridge Road (Lake Avenue in Glenview to Skokie Boulevard)***
  - Completed work for this location includes installation of inlet filters, sidewalk saw

cuts, silt fence installation, storm sewer work, pavement binder, and pavement milling.

- Resurfacing work and electrical work continues
- **Walters Road (Landwehr Road to Pfingsten Road)**
  - Completed work for this location includes installation of inlet filters, sidewalk construction, silt fence installation, storm sewer work, pavement binder, pavement surface, and pavement milling.
  - Electrical work continues.

### **2025 Asphalt Street Rehabilitation Program**

The contractor will begin asphalt rehabilitation work next week beginning on the west side of Greenwood Road. Impacted residents will receive a doorhanger notification 72 hours in advance of the scheduled work. Affected driveways may be inaccessible for approximately 5 to 7 business days. Residents may sign up to receive regular project updates via the Village's "NotifyMe" notification system. Notifications will be sent to subscribers via email and/or text message.
