Updates

Metra Station Platform Replacement

The Village has been notified by Metra that starting in mid-to-late September, Metra will begin work to remove the existing brick surface on the east side platform of the Metra Station, both north and south of Shermer Road. The platform will be resurfaced with a new material to meet current Metra design standards. The project is expected to take approximately 4–5 weeks and will be completed in at least two phases (north and south of Shermer Road). During

construction, Metra will adjust train stops as needed to allow passengers to safely board and exit, with no impact on the operation of the crossing gates.

Shermer Road Corridor Improvements

During the week, construction work continued on Shermer Road between Willow Road and Walters Avenue, including excavation and parkway grading to accommodate the shared-use path to be constructed on the east side of Shermer. Work continued as well on curb and gutter replacement and storm sewer structures.

This next week, there is a scheduled water main shutdown near the intersection of Stanley Street and Shermer Road on Friday, August 29 at 9 am which is required to relocate hydrants. More than 100 residents and businesses will begin receiving notices on Friday, August 22 to allow at minimum a 72-hour notice before water main shutdowns. The watermain shutdown is anticipated to require 6-8 hours to complete and the water service will be restored following relocation of the hydrants.

Children's Bicycle Helmet Reward Program

The Police Department has started the Children's Bicycle Helmet Reward Program. When officers see a juvenile (under the age of 16) riding their bicycle with a helmet, they can give the rider a McDonald's or Culver's Sweet Treat card and a Garner Cycle raffle ticket. The recipient can complete the raffle ticket and turn it in at Garner Cycle for their bicycle giveaway on November 7.

Pavement Markings

A Village contractor is working in portions of northwest and northeast Northbrook to re-paint roadway pavement marking. This project is intended to enhance safety and improve visibility for drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians, and is anticipated to be completed by Friday, September 5.

Planned Inspection for Public Works Fuel Island – August 26 and 27

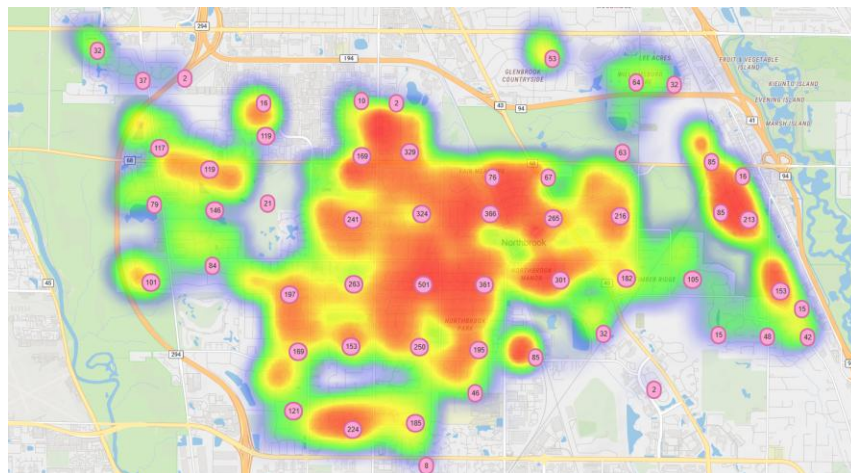
The Village's required internal fuel tank inspections, mandated by the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal, are scheduled for August 26–27. During this time, the tanks will be drained for inspection, and Public Works is coordinating fueling solutions until the station is refilled and back in service. If the tanks do not pass the inspection, the Village will be required to replace them and the fueling station, however as a governmental entity the Village will be able to keep operating while the Village works to replace the tanks. The replacement of the station has been identified in the Capital Improvement Plan and adopted FY26 Budget.

Final Nicor Gas Main Replacement Restoration Completed

On Wednesday, August 20, Nicor completed roadway striping restoration on Shermer Road from Walters Avenue to 1310 Shermer Road. With the completion of this striping restoration, Nicor has completed all the work for this gas main replacement project.

Automated Water Meter Project

The Village of Northbrook continues to move forward with the installation of new meters that began on April 22. As of Thursday, August 21, a total of 7,367 installations have been completed. The areas where meters have been installed are identified on the map below.



During the period of August 25-29, 383 replacements have been scheduled. In total 8,089 of the 12,203-meter replacements have been installed or are currently scheduled to be replaced over the coming weeks.

Postcards have been mailed to customers in portions of all Billing Zones. These postcards outline the necessary steps to schedule an appointment for their meter to be replaced. Meter replacements can be scheduled after a customer receives a postcard. Meter replacement

appointments are scheduled in 2-hour windows but take approximately 30 minutes to complete. Information on the Automated Water Meter Project is available [here](#).

Cook County Roadway Construction Projects

Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways continues resurfacing work for the three projects within the Village.

Project Locations and Updates:

- ***Landwehr Road (Hampton Court in Glenview to Dundee Road)***
 - Next week, the County anticipates continuing sidewalk construction, resurfacing work, permanent pavement markings, and electrical work.
- ***Walters Avenue (Landwehr Road to Pfingsten Road)***
 - Next week, the County anticipates continuing resurfacing work, permanent pavement markings, and electrical work.
- ***Sunset Ridge Road (Lake Avenue in Glenview to Skokie Boulevard) – COMPLETE***

Building Permit Activity

- A building permit application has been received for interior renovations proposed at the future location of Lifetime Fitness, located at 1300 Techny Road.

Business License Activity

- An Outdoor Dining License has been issued to Roti restaurant, located at 798 Skokie Boulevard.
- A Business License has been issued to Cutesy Body USA, located at 3000 Dundee Road, Suite 112.
