Updates

Metra Station Platform Rehabilitation

Beginning the week of September 1, Metra has advised the Village they will begin work to remove the existing brick surface on the east side platform of the Metra Station, both north and south of Shermer Road. The platform will be resurfaced with a new material to meet current Metra design standards. The project will be completed in at least two phases starting with the outbound platform as follows:

- **Phase 1:** The Outbound Platform north of Shermer Road and a portion south of Shermer Road (Outbound Platform) will be out of service for approximately two weeks.
- **Phase 2:** Following completion of Phase 1, the remaining portion of the Outbound Platform south of Shermer Road will be out of service for approximately two weeks.

The pedestrian crosswalk will remain in service for the primary duration of work. A map of the project area is provided below.



Nicor Gas Main Replacement

On Monday, August 25, Nicor Gas began construction for a gas main replacement project located east of the Milwaukee District North Metra tracks, south of Walters Avenue, west of Waukegan Road, and north of Illinois Road (see map below). Impacted residents were notified in advance.



Shermer Road Corridor Improvements

Work on Shermer Road between Willow Road and Walters Avenue continues with focus on the removal and replacement of both concrete panels and concrete curb and gutter on northbound Shermer Road. Today, August 29, hydrant relocation is underway during a scheduled water main shutdown. No work will occur on Monday, September 1, in observance of the Labor Day holiday.

Automated Water Meter Project

The Village has completed installation or has an appointment to complete the new meter installation at 8,992 of the 12,203 water meters in Northbrook. All customers have been mailed postcards for appointment scheduling as well. Scheduled in 2-hour windows, appointments take approximately 30 minutes to complete. Cook County Roadway Construction Projects

Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways has completed the resurfacing project work on Sunset Ridge Road (Lake Avenue in Glenview to Skokie Boulevard). Projects on Landwehr Road (Hampton Court in Glenview to Dundee Road) as well as Walters Avenue (Landwehr Road to Pfingsten Road) continues.

Street Sweeping

Public Works crews have begun its second street sweeping cycle for the summer season. This work is being performed in the Central Business District and on Village-owned roadways and residential streets. This cycle is anticipated to be completed by Wednesday, September 3.

Lake Michigan Intake Inspections

This week the Village inspected the raw water intakes in Lake Michigan. The inspections ensure

the pipes carrying water to the Lake Front Pump Station are structurally sound and protected. To complete these inspections, the Village hires a commercial diving firm to visually inspect and make intermediate repairs while the inspect is occurring.
