Updates

2025 Sidewalk Replacement Program

The Village routinely inspects sidewalks to identify safety hazards and areas needing ADA-compliant ramps. Work began September 8 and will continue in the following areas over the next 2–3 weeks:

- Illinois Road, between Shermer Road and Western Avenue
- Woodlawn Road, between Shermer Road and Western Avenue
- Oak Street, between Shermer Road and Lorenz Drive

Residents were notified of the project by mail in August. Additional notices will be hand-delivered 24–48 hours before driveway closures, during which affected residents may park on the street during construction.

Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Expressway and Ramp Closures

IDOT will be performing nighttime roadwork during the weeks of September 15 and September 22 on the Edens/I-94 and US41. This work will result in 1-lane closures as well as intermittent partial and full ramp closures. This will impact US 41 from Park Avenue to Lake-Cook Road and the Edens Expressway/I-94 from Lake-Cook Road to the I-90 Kennedy Junction. The known ramp closures that directly impact Northbrook are:

Monday, Sept 15

- Southbound entrances ramp on to Edens
 - East Bound and West Bound Dundee
 - Lake-Cook
- South Bound exit ramp off of Edens/I-94 to Lake-Cook Road

Monday, Sept 22

- South Bound exit ramp to:
 - Skokie Blvd
 - Tower Rd
- South Bound entrance ramp:
 - West Bound and East Bound Willow Road

Metra Station Platform Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation work on the outbound platform began in early September on sections north and south of Shermer Road and remains on schedule. Phase 2 focuses on the remaining portion of the outbound platform south of Shermer Road. The platform project is on track to be complete by mid-October. The pedestrian crosswalk will remain open throughout most of the work. According to Metra, during this work residents may hear train horns due to the construction. These horns may sound even outside normal construction hours. Residents with concerns can contact Metra Customer Service at 312-696-3872.



Nicor Gas Main Replacement

On September 13 work is expected to begin on Maple Avenue. Next week, work will continue on the eastern half, including Sycamore Lane, Spruce Street, Illinois Road, Church Street, and Orchard Road. As part of the project, Nicor is scheduling appointments with property owners to televise sanitary sewer services, and storm sewers, if applicable. If no exterior access point is available, interior access may be required. After inspections, lawns will be marked. Once all

inspections and utility markings are complete, Nicor will begin installing new gas mains and connecting service lines to affected properties.

Shermer Road Corridor Improvements

Next week, crews will continue installing light pole foundations and underground conduit along northbound Shermer Road, as well as performing storm sewer structure adjustments. Additionally, on Wednesday, September 17 at 9 a.m., the water main will be shutdown near the intersection of Oak Avenue and Shermer Road to relocate fire hydrants. Residents and businesses began receiving notices this week. The shutdown is expected to last 6–8 hours, after which water service will be restored.

Cook County Roadway Construction Projects

Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways continues work on Landwehr Road (Hampton Court in Glenview to Dundee Road) and Walters Avenue (Landwehr Road to Pfingsten Road). Both projects still require completion of electrical work and new traffic signal installations. The contractors still need to perform landscaping and other associated items.
