WaterSmart Portal Launches October 1

Starting October 1, the Village of Northbrook will launch a free online portal designed to help residents monitor water use, conserve resources, and spot potential leaks early. Brill LEAD Training

The Northbrook Police administration along with several officers participated in the Illinois Holocaust Museum & Education Center's Brill LEAD Training, at NIPSTA (Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy) this week. The program provides training and tools necessary for understanding abuses of authority, responding to hate crimes and bias, and is a proven program that impacts how law enforcement officers approach their jobs with empathy. LEAD is certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board.

Email Scam in Northbrook

The Village was made aware of a fraudulent email scam targeting Northbrook residents and businesses. Scammers are sending messages that falsely claim to be from the Village, using addresses such as *planning.northbrook.il@usa.com* or other public email services. These accounts are NOT legitimate Village email addresses. The scam email includes a fake invoice requesting a wire transfer payment, which we do not accept as a valid form of payment. The invoice falsely uses the Village of Northbrook's address. Northbrook unfortunately is one of a number of area municipalities that has been impacted by this scam.
