## *Updates*

### **Village Launches WaterSmart Leak Alerts**

On October 1, the Village launched WaterSmart Leak Alerts, a new customer portal feature for residents and businesses to assist in detecting potential water leaks for customers that have completed installation of a new water meter. The system monitors for unusual or continuous use, such as 2 gallons per hour for 12 hours in homes or 10 gallons per hour for 48 hours in other buildings, and alerts customers by email with details on when the leak began, the type detected, and estimated flow rate. On its first day, 280 alerts were issued, with 14 confirmed leaks inside a home/business. The Village asks all water customers to register for the free portal at [northbrookil.watersmart.com](http://northbrookil.watersmart.com) and log in with your utility billing account number and zip code.

### **Cook County Homeowner Relief Fund**

Cook County recently launched the [Cook County Homeowner Relief Fund](#), a \$15 million program that will assist households that have experienced a substantial increase on their

property tax bills in recent years and will provide one-time payments of \$1,000 to eligible households. Eligibility requirements include:

- A property tax bill increase of at least 50% in any of the 2021, 2022 or 2023 tax years
  - NOTE: This includes those who went from a zero-property tax bill to a non-zero bill in tax years 2021, 2022 or 2023.
- An income at or below 100% of the Cook County Area Median Income (AMI) for the applicant's household size

### **Northbrook Hires New Firefighters**

Three of the six firefighters are nationally licensed paramedics, the remaining three new hires have earned their EMT-Basic licenses and will be attending paramedic school through Highland Park Hospital in Spring 2026.
