### **Sales Tax Monthly Report**

The monthly sales tax data [found at this link](#) for collections through August 2025 (distributed to the Village in November 2025) came in at \$1,855,834 which is \$281,735 or 17.8%, greater than the monthly amount collected in November 2024 (August 2024). This sales tax amount included the automatic 1% municipal, 1% home rule, and 3% local cannabis taxes.

### **Extension Of Time to Use Gas Powered Leaf Blowers**

Effective October 31, 2025, the Village Manager has determined that the use of gas-powered leaf blowers in the fall of 2025 shall be permissible for an additional month through December 31, 2025.
